



**NASHOBA ASSOCIATED BOARDS OF HEALTH
SHARPS COLLECTION PROGRAM**

In an attempt to provide an inexpensive method to properly disposal of syringes (sharps) the Nashoba Associated Board of Health has established the following program for its member communities.

- 1.) Sharps containers will be available at you local Town Hall for purchase (the purchase price covers the cost of disposal).
- 2.) Once the container is full it can be brought to the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health Building, in Ayer or the Nashoba Nursing Service in Shirley (directions and maps attached) during the following times Monday-Friday 9:00am to 4:00pm.
- 3.) When dropping of the full container, new containers can be purchased.
- 4.) Sharps can only be accepted in approved containers; persons who bring loose sharps or sharps in unapproved containers (i.e. detergent bottle or coffee can) will need to purchase the appropriate container for disposal and place the sharps in that container before they can be accepted.

Directions to Ayer Office

Main Street Ayer to Columbia Street (road between Post Office and Town Hall) to first right directly behind Post Office Central Ave. (5th building on left, brick #30)

Nursing Map & Directions

From the West: Travel Route 2 East to exit 36 (Shirley Road)

Turn slight right onto Shirley Road. Follow for approximately 2 miles.

Take a right at stop sign onto Main Street.

Approximately 1/2 mile on right, take a right onto Phoenix Street.

Take first left after pond into Phoenix Park.

From the East: Travel Route 2 West to exit 36 (Shirley Road)

Stay right off of exit to stop sign. Take right at stop sign and go approximately

100 yards to another stop sign. Take a left onto Shirley Road.

Follow for approximately 2 miles. Take a right at stop sign onto Main Street.

Approximately 1/2 mile on right, take a right onto Phoenix St.

Take first left after pond into Phoenix Park.
